ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS [CONSTITUTION]

Section 1: The Constitution may be amended at any General Assembly or Special Session of Region II by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the present members, provided that the amendment has been submitted in writing to the Region II Secretary at least two calendar weeks prior to a TJCSGA Convention, Regional conference, or special session.

<u>Section 2:</u> Executive Board shall suggest to the Legislative Committee to see to the modification or amendment of the constitution.

<u>Section 3:</u> As a member of TJCSGA, the Region II Constitution recognizes the TJCSGA Constitution as a superior document.
