Standing Rules

Rule 1. No delegate shall speak longer than three minutes, without permission of the convention granted by a two thirds vote without debate.

(a) No more than two delegates for an issue. No more than two delegates against an issue.

(b) Will not exceed more than three minutes.

Rule 2. All reports and other material for the permanent record or printed proceeding committee discussions.

A. For each motion made by every committee in front of the General Assembly, discussion will be limited to two delegates “for” and two delegates “against.” Each delegate who speaks will be limited to three minutes. Time will be kept by the parliamentarian.

B. The delegate who has presented the motion has the first opportunity at discussion.

Rule 3. The rules contained in the current edition of Robert’s Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern the convention in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with the bylaws of the society and these standing rules.

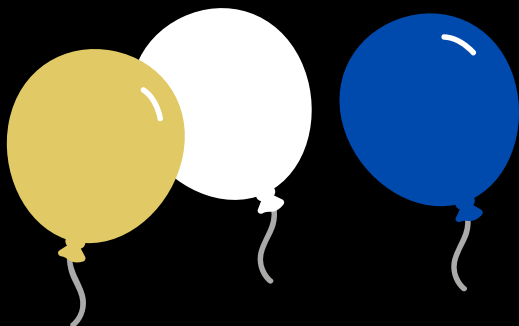

Cheat Sheet

Phrasing: State your name, position, and school you represent, then say "I move" state response.

To	Response (phrase)
Introduce a business (make a motion)	<i>"Madame President. I (State name), (position) so move to..."</i>
Amend a Motion	<i>"I move that this motion be amended by..."</i>
Second a Motion	<i>"Madame President. I (state name), (position) Second the motion..."</i>
Object to Personal affront or Procedure	<i>"Point of Order" (Officers' Privilege)</i>
Complaint about noise, room temp. etc.	<i>"Point of Privilege" (Officers' Privilege).</i>
Request Info	<i>"Request of Information"</i>
Consider Something out of the scheduled order.	<i>"I move we suspend the rules and Consider..."</i>
Postpone consideration of something.	<i>"I move we postpone this matter until/After..."</i>
