SPECIAL RULES

RULE 1. EACH MEMBER HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SPEAK ON A SUBJECT BEING DEBATED.

(A) DELEGATES MAY SPEAK FOR NO LONGER THAN 90 SECONDS PER MOTION OR RESOLUTION BEING DEBATED UNTIL ALL DELEGATES HAVE HAD A CHANCE TO SPEAK.

(B) ONCE ALL DELEGATES COMPLETE THEIR DEBATE ON THE MOTION OR RESOLUTION, EACH DELEGATE MAY SPEAK AGAIN FOR A MAXIMUM OF 90 SECONDS PER MOTION OR RESOLUTION.

(C) DELEGATES MAY ONLY SPEAK TWICE ON ANY SINGLE MOTION OR RESOLUTION.

(D) IN ACCORDANCE WITH TJCSGA AND REGION 2 PROTOCOLS, CHAPTERS OR REGIONS MAY NOT INTRODUCE NEW RESOLUTIONS WITHOUT GOING THROUGH THE PROPER CHANNELS AND MEETING APPROPRIATE DEADLINES.

(E) THE PARLIAMENTARIAN WILL MONITOR THE LENGTH OF TIME FOR EACH DELEGATE AS THEY DEBATE.

(F) THE PARLIAMENTARIAN HAS THE AUTHORITY TO STOP THE DEBATE ONCE 90 SECONDS HAVE EXPIRED REGARDLESS IF THE DELEGATE IS DONE SPEAKING.

RULE 2. ALL REPORTS AND OTHER MATERIAL FOR THE PERMANENT RECORD OR PRINTED PROCEEDING COMMITTEE DISCUSSIONS.


(A) THE DELEGATE WHO HAS PRESENTED THE MOTION HAS THE FIRST OPPORTUNITY AT THE DISCUSSION.

RULE 3. THE RULES IN THE CURRENT EDITION OF ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER NEWLY REVISED SHALL GOVERN THE CONFERENCE IN ALL CASES TO WHICH THEY APPLY. THEY ARE NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE BYLAWS OF THE SOCIETY AND THESE SPECIAL RULES.

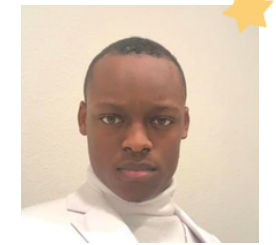
Stephen Rogers
